

STUDENT FUNDING OPTIONS for COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES STUDENTS

SHORT TERM EMBEDDED COURSES:

If you are participating in an international embedded course, you may apply to two sources for funding.

Funds from College of Agricultural Sciences study abroad endowments are available through our Office of International Programs. The application is available on-line at: <http://agsci.psu.edu/international/undergraduates/funding/funding-application>. The deadline for spring/summer embedded courses is **January 31** and for fall/winter break embedded courses is **September 30**.

Applications for resources at the university level are available through the University Office of Global Programs. Go to <http://global.psu.edu/info/going-abroad/students/funding-study-abroad>. Then click on Study Abroad Scholarships.

One scholarship, the [Commonwealth EA Application](#), is available for embedded courses through this office. Deadlines are:

- **January 15** – spring semester embedded programs with a travel component during spring break.
- **March 15** – all embedded programs with a travel component in the Maymester or summer semester.
- **October 1** – fall semester embedded programs with a travel component in the fall, late December or early January.

Other funding sources include clubs and organizations you belong to, local businesses and organizations in your hometown, and on-line resources. Do some research!

Fundraisers are a good way to raise money as well. Some ideas are:
